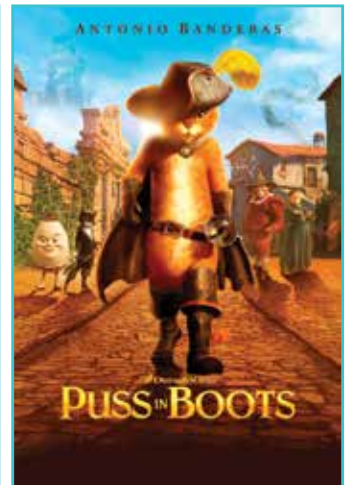
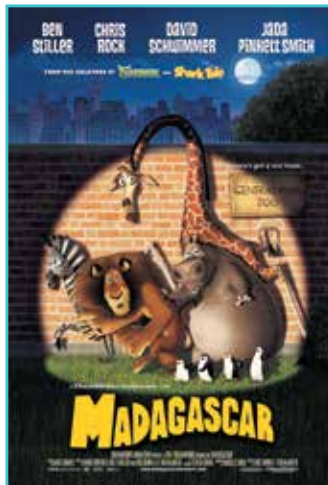
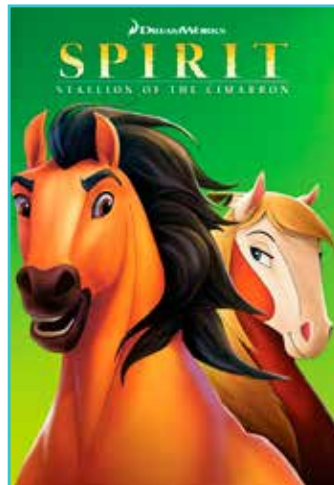
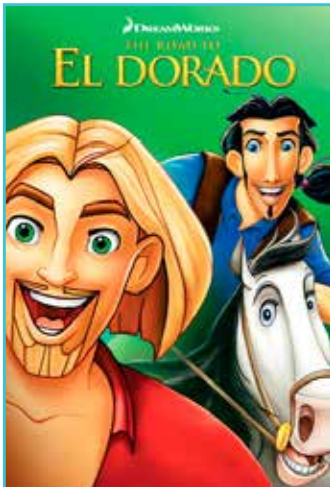
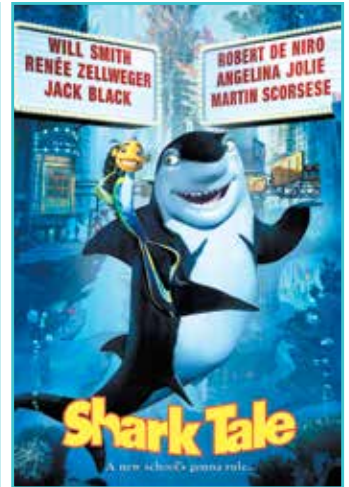
This HBO Films presentation reunites Al Pacino and director Barry Levinson (HBO's *You Don't Know Jack*) in a compelling portrait of Penn State's longtime head-football coach, Joe Paterno, as he is embroiled in the infamous Jerry Sandusky sexual-abuse scandal, forcing Paterno's ouster at the same time he learned he had cancer. The story focuses not only on Paterno (Pacino) and his family but on Sara Ganim (Riley Keough) the 23-year-old reporter and Penn State grad who broke the story in *The Patriot-News*, a local newspaper. In November 2011, six days after becoming the winningest football coach in NCAA college history, Paterno's legacy is challenged over the course of one explosive week, as he is forced to face questions of institutional failure in regard to Sandusky's young victims. Dismissed from his job before the 2011 season ended, Paterno died just over a month later at the age of 85.
