# WHERE CAN I ACQUIRE THE MOVIES I WANT TO SHOW?

You can show movies that are secured from any legal source (DVDs, digital copies, streaming, etc). This includes renting, borrowing, or using movies from your personal home collection.

#### **HOW CAN I USE MY LICENSE TO HOST MOVIE FUNDRAISERS?**

Bringing families together with movie events is one of the most popular ways movies are shown in schools. By following these few simple guidelines below, you can stay in compliance while raising funds for your school.

- 1. When fundraising at movie events, an unlimited amount of funds can be raised for the school. These funds can come from suggested donations, concessions, giveaways, and more. Some popular event ideas are Dinner and a Movie, Parents' Night Out, or Book-to-Movie themed showings. ## HOW DO I RENEW MY MOVIE LICENSE SO I CAN KEEP MY **SCHOOL BUILDING COVERED AT ALL TIMES?**

Your public performance site license is scheduled to renew at the end of your selected initial agreement. A renewal packet containing your license and invoice will be mailed 30 days prior to your current license's expiration date. Once the renewal invoice is paid, the new license will be active for the dates listed. Licenses are available in 1-3 year terms.
